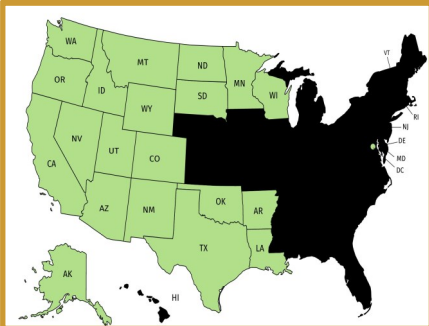

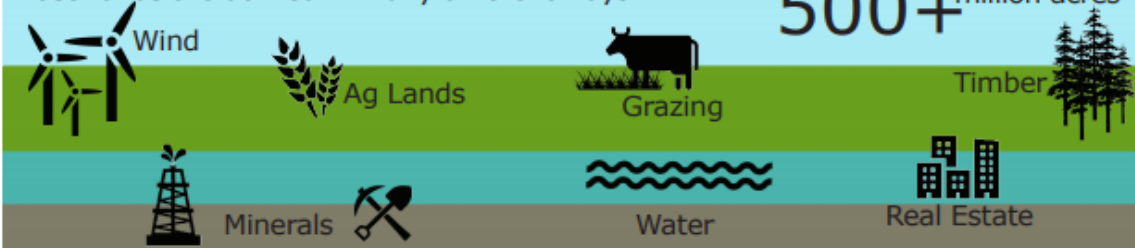
Desired Outcomes of the Affiliate Membership Program
