NASTL Member State: California

The California State Lands Commission manages four million acres of tide and submerged lands and the beds of natural and navigable rivers, streams, lakes, bays, estuaries, inlets, and straits. These are often referred to as sovereign lands or Public Trust lands. The Commission is also the trustee of approximately a half-million acres of land, known as School Lands, that were granted to the state by the U.S. Government in 1853, and which are managed for the benefit of the State Teachers Retirement System. The Commission's Public Trust Lands and School Lands are each subject to specific statutory and common law trust responsibilities that the Commission carries out on behalf of the state.

The information provided in this form applies only to California's School Lands as there is no permanent fund for sovereign (Public Trust) lands. Generally, revenue generated on sovereign (Public Trust) lands goes to California's general fund.
